Volunteer Community service organizations

Engagement of community volunteers for town clean-up projects was discussed.

Louise would like to clean up weeds and grass along Elmwood Avenue curbs. Safety issue makes this inappropriate for citizen project even if volunteers were available.

Discussion ensued about available volunteer organizations and difficulty in maintaining participation. Summer part-time employees were suggested for various clean-up projects at Town Hall where they are already working.

Monroe Ave GIGP project maintenance and replanting and on-going funding was discussed. Maintenance district formation and process was also discussed.
