- A diverse planting buffer should be implemented between proposed site improvements and Allen's Creek.
- Use of native plants is highly encouraged.
- Planting of street trees along Brighton Henrietta Town Line Road is encouraged.

- Use of green infrastructure techniques should be incorporated.
- Consider construction of a sidewalk along Brighton Henrietta Town Line Road.
