Due to ongoing concerns with the current COVID-19 situation, The Town of Brighton Recreation Department & Parks Department would like to provide the following updates:

- The Recreation & Parks Department are now closed and operating remotely via email and telephone, please allow 24 hours for response to any inquiries.
- Brighton Recreation Department is suspending **ALL** Recreation & Senior programming, events, drop-in groups, etc. offered by the Recreation Department & Brighton Seniors until further notice.
- All Park lodges, playgrounds, shelters, and athletic fields are closed until further notice. Reservations are not being accepted at this time.
- Town parks and trails remain open. Please practice social distancing by staying at least 6' away from other people.
