Brighton Town Supervisor Issues Emergency Order to Support Social Distancing

Brighton Town Supervisor William W. Moehle issued an Emergency Order today establishing "no parking" along certain streets near Corbett's Glen Nature Park and closing the parking lot at Corbett's Glen. The Order also prohibits garage sales. This action has been taken to support social distancing required during the COVID-19 health emergency.

Corbett's Glen has experienced an extraordinary increase in usage and has narrow trails. The parking restrictions will help decrease user density and promote social distancing. The parking lot at Corbett's Glen is now closed and parking is prohibited at all times on the following streets in the Town of Brighton:

Inwood Dr.	Both	Penfield Rd. to Stoneham Rd.

Garage sales are also prohibited as they promote social congregation at a time when social distance is extremely important to help reduce the number of people exposed to COVID-19.

There are no parking changes at other Town parks.

Emergency Order 2020.01 follows.

TOWN OF BRIGHTON EMERGENCY ORDER 2020.01

Dated: April 9, 2020

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, I declared a State of Emergency in the Town of Brighton, pursuant to Article 2-B of the Executive Law of the State of New York, due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Section 24(1) of the Executive Law of the State of New York authorizes the issuance of emergency orders to protect life and property or to bring the emergency situation under control.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, William W. Moehle, Supervisor of the Town of Brighton, do hereby order that parking be prohibited at all times on the following streets in the Town of Brighton:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Avon Dr.	Both	Forest Hills Dr. to Beverly Dr.
Dale Rd.	Both	Dale Rd. East to and including cul de sac
Forest Hills Rd.	Both	Penfield Rd. to Beverly Dr.
Glen Rd.	Both	Rt. 441 to the end of the dedicated roadway
Inwood Dr.	Both	Penfield Rd. to Stoneham Rd.

These provisions shall supersede any existing inconsistent parking restrictions on any of these streets under Chapter 185 of the Brighton Town Code.

I FURTHER ORDER, that the parking lot for Corbett’s Glen Nature Park located on Penfield Rd. is closed to all vehicles. Parking and standing are prohibited in such parking lot.

I FURTHER ORDER, that the provisions of Town Code Sections 76-2 through 76-7 and Sections 76-9 through 76-10 are immediately suspended until further order, and all Garage Sales, as such term is defined in Section 76-1 of the Brighton Town Code, shall hereby be prohibited within the Town of Brighton. Sections 76-8 relating to the Right of entry for enforcement and inspection, Section 76-11, concerning Notices of violation and Section 76-12, concerning Penalties for offenses, in each case, of the

Brighton Town Code, shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to any violations of this Order relating to Garage Sales.

I FURTHER ORDER that each violation of any provision of the above Orders shall be punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor with a fine to be imposed of not less than \$100.
