Due to ongoing concerns with the current COVID-19 situation, the Town of Brighton Recreation Department would like to provide the following Summer Program related updates:

The Town of Brighton prepared the Summer 2020 Recreation Newsletter in March, and all information contained in the Summer Brochure is subject to change based on the impact of COVID-19. **Unfortunately, we have had to make the difficult decision to DELAY the start of Summer Program Registrations, including Playground Camp registration, due to the uncertainty of our ability to return to normal activities.**

We will **NOT** start Summer Program registration until we know that we will be able to safely meet the needs of your family and comply with all State and County requirements, while keeping our staff as safe as possible. We will communicate new registration start dates as soon as we feel confident in doing so. **Please do not mail any registration forms, they will be returned to you.**

We understand that Recreation is an important and necessary part of everyone's life, but the safety of our participants, community and staff are of the utmost importance to us.
