



# TOWN OF BRIGHTON RECREATION DEPARTMENT SUMMER PROGRAM UPDATE June 3, 2020

**The Town of Brighton Recreation Department would like to provide the following Summer Program related updates:**

Governor Cuomo announced yesterday that summer day camps may open on June 29. However, at this time, the guidelines on how to do that safely have not been released. We will be working closely with the Monroe County Health Department to evaluate if we can provide a safe and manageable camp experience for all participants and staff. The Town of Brighton understands the importance of Summer Recreation and will be making a decision very shortly on holding Summer Camp.

All registration for in person summer programming, including camps, remains closed at this time. The Town Hall pool will remain closed for the summer. Updates will be provided on camps and programs as the situation evolves. We continue to evaluate our ability to return to any in person programming as deemed appropriate following all local and state guidelines.

Registration for our online programming remains open. We continue to work with our instructors and staff to develop online programs options. Please see our website, [www.townofbrighton.org/rec](http://www.townofbrighton.org/rec), for available online programs and to register.

We will **NOT** move forward with any in person Summer Program registration until we know that we will be able to safely meet the needs of your family and comply with all State and County requirements, while keeping our staff as safe as possible. We will communicate new registration information as soon as we feel confident in doing so. **Please do not mail any registration forms, they will be returned to you.**

We will continue to update the public on our anticipated return to normal operations. The Recreation Office remains closed to the public, but is operating remotely.
