Brighton Town Hall Begins Reopening with Appointments Only

The Town of Brighton will open Town Hall on an appointment-only basis beginning Monday, June 8. Visitors with appointments must enter through the front or rear door of the Public Safety wing, as all other entrances are currently closed. In an effort to protect both residents and employees, the Town will continue to provide most services over the phone or online. Town Hall can be reached by calling 784-5250.

“The COVID-19 pandemic forced us to review our service delivery and do as much remotely as possible. I think we’ve done that very well, and benefitted from a more efficient, less paper-dependent process for handling everything from dog licenses to assessment reviews,” said Town Supervisor William W. Moehle. “We will continue our high quality customer service by helping people on the phone, through email or online, while leaving more complicated transactions for in-person appointments if necessary.”

Other Town buildings and departments will function as follows: The Brighton Memorial Library is open for curbside pickup only, call 784-5300; the Parks and Recreation Departments at Brookside remain closed to the public but available by phone at 784-5260, Ext. 0; the Highway Department is closed to the public; the Police Department continues taking visitors by appointment, as they have done since the start of the pandemic, call 784-5150; the Court office is partially open but Court is not in session, call 784-5152 for more information.
