Brighton Offers Streamlined Permit Process for Outdoor Dining

The Town of Brighton has created a streamlined process for restaurants seeking a permit to add or expand outdoor dining at their establishments as allowed by Gov. Cuomo as part of the Finger Lakes Region reopening. Under Emergency Order 2020.11, Brighton Town Supervisor William W. Moehle relaxed restrictions on outdoor dining to help businesses recovering from financial hardship caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Restaurateurs seeking to add or expand outdoor seating may apply for permits online at the Town's website www.townofbrighton.org.

"Our local eateries and stores are part of what make Brighton such a great place. Getting these businesses back on their feet is important, and the Town is committed to assisting these businesses as best we can," said Brighton Town Supervisor William W. Moehle. "We will continue to work in partnership with businesses and other organizations to find creative ways to restart public life, while supporting public health."

Brighton has already reviewed and approved several outdoor seating permits submitted to the Town since yesterday.
