Town of Brighton Cancels Bands at Buckland Summer Concert Series

The Town of Brighton is canceling its annual Bands at Buckland Summer Concert Series planned for July and August 2020. There are no State guidelines available for future public gatherings as the phased-in reopening of the Finger Lakes region is contingent upon the how the number of COVID-19 positive cases trend. As a result, the Town of Brighton is unable to move forward with the Summer Concert Series.

“As our region reopens, it is critical that people remain vigilant about handwashing, mask wearing and social distancing so that we do not have a spike in COVID-19 infections,” said Supervisor William W.
