Applicants Sought for Brighton Conservation Board

The Town of Brighton is seeking applicants for membership on its Conservation Board. The Conservation Board reviews property development proposals for such matters as drainage, landscaping and environmental protection. It considers environmental issues and concerns for site-plan approvals, open space development, woodlots, watercourses, etc. and advises the Planning Board regarding these actions. The Board's overall intent is to preserve the Town's natural environment and control impacts on the surrounding neighborhood, while balancing the Town's need for an economically viable and environmentally sustainable future.

Applicants must be Town residents and available for meeting on the first or second Tuesdays of the month at 7 PM. The 2020 Conservation Board meeting schedule can be viewed on the Town's website. Due to COVID-19, meetings are currently being held virtually through video conferencing. Members are appointed to two-year terms.
