- Town Hall is **open on an appointment-only basis**. Visitors with appointments must wear masks & enter through the front or rear door of the Public Safety wing, as all other entrances are closed. - Brighton Police Department has restricted access for non-emergency issues. Call in advance at 784-5150.

- The Farmers Market is open through Nov. 22. Join us on Sundays from 9AM – 1 PM at Brighton High School. We have new operating procedures for COVID safety, so visit <https://brightonfarmersmarket.org/>
- Containerized & bulk yard debris is being picked up. Residents may also bring [yard debris](#) to the Highway Dept. at 1941 Elmwood Ave.
- Recreation programs are limited. Brookside is closed to the public. Questions? Call 784-5260 ext. 0.
- The parking lot at Corbett's Glen Nature Park is now open. But, "no parking" is posted along some surrounding streets.
- Athletic Fields are open for low to moderate risk sports. Basketball Courts remain closed as identified by NYS as a high risk activity.
- Park lodges are CLOSED.
- Town parks, trails and playgrounds are open. Please **practice social distancing** by staying at least 6' away from other people and **wear a mask**.
