NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual Election for the Brighton Fire District will be held on December 12, 2017, at Station #1, located at 3100 East Avenue, Rochester, New York 14610, at which time the polls for voting will be open between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing one (1) Fire Commissioner for a term of five (5) years which term is to commence January 1, 2018 and end December 31, 2022.

Candidates for the office of Fire Commissioner must be residents of the Brighton Fire District at the time of the election and during the term of office. Any candidate for the office of Fire Commissioner must file his or her name on the Brighton Fire District's Official Petition Form, with the Secretary of the Fire District, no later than November 22, 2017, by the official Brighton Fire District nominating petition subscribed to by at least twenty-five (25) electors residing within the Brighton Fire District, if such candidate desires his or her name to be inserted upon the ballots to be used at such election.

The following proposition shall also be submitted to the voters for determination:

Proposition #1

Shall the following Resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Brighton Fire District, entitled, **RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRIGHTON FIRE DISTRICT TO SELL TWO 2007 E-ONE PUMPERS**, adopted November 2, 2017, and authorizing and empowering the Board of Fire Commissioners to carry out the sale of two (2) 2007 E-ONE PUMPERS, valued at more than fifty thousand (\$50,000) dollars each, with the actual price of sale to be determined by the market, be approved?

All persons who have been residents of the Brighton Fire District for at least thirty (30) days preceding the election, and who registered to vote with the Monroe County Board of Elections at least twenty-three (23) days before the election are eligible to vote at such Brighton Fire District election.
